Robust California Turnout at 2013 GFOA Annual Conference

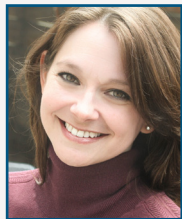
I'm filing this month's president's column while attending the Government Finance Officers Association annual conference in San Francisco.
