#### Fed's Pace of Tightening More Significant Than Timing?

Speculation about when the Federal Reserve will increase its benchmark interest rate from near zero has been prevalent for the better part of the last 18 months, if not longer, and the Fed's decision in October to delay a pickup in rates did little to settle the uncertainty.

While the timing of the increase is obviously important as it will mark a shift from policies that stemmed from the financial downturn of more than seven years ago, it is more likely that the trajectory, or pace, of ensuing rate increases will have a more significant impact on the economy as well as the long-term management of an institution's investment portfolio.
