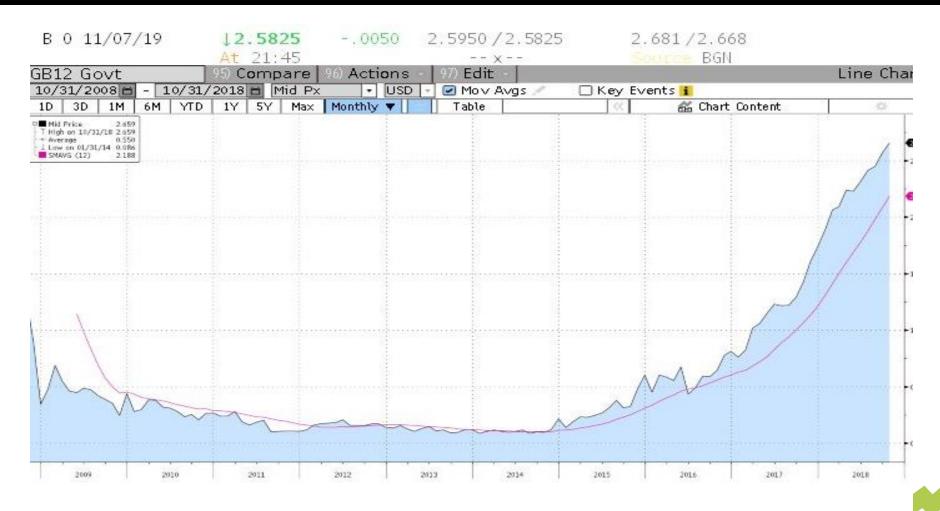


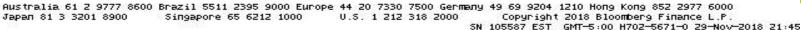






Last 10 Years – 1 Year Treasury Rates







Last 18 Years – 1 Year Treasury Rates



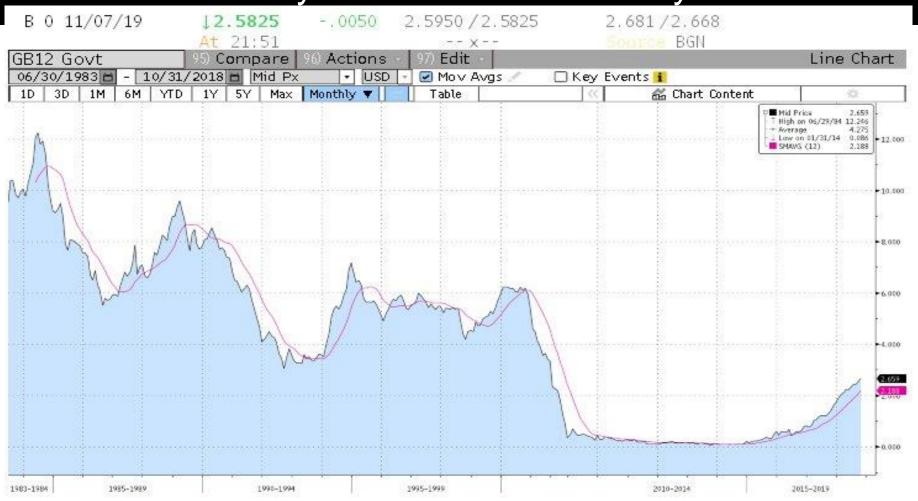
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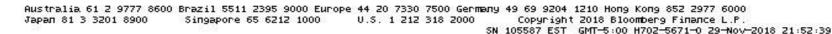
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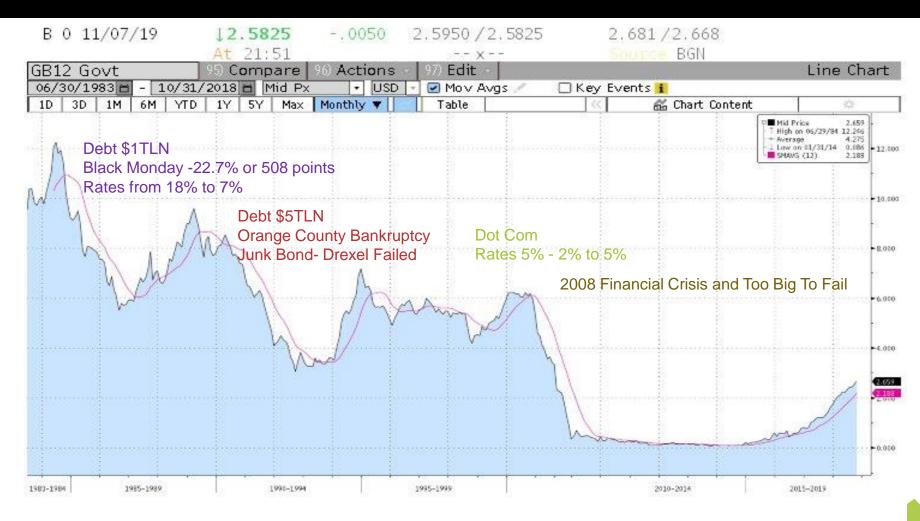


Last 35 years – 1 Year Treasury Rates

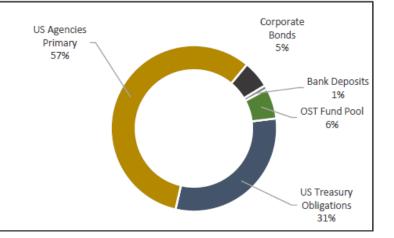

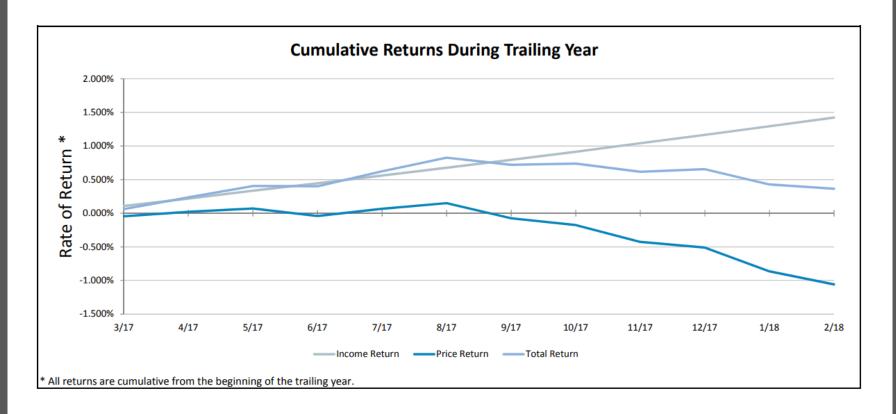

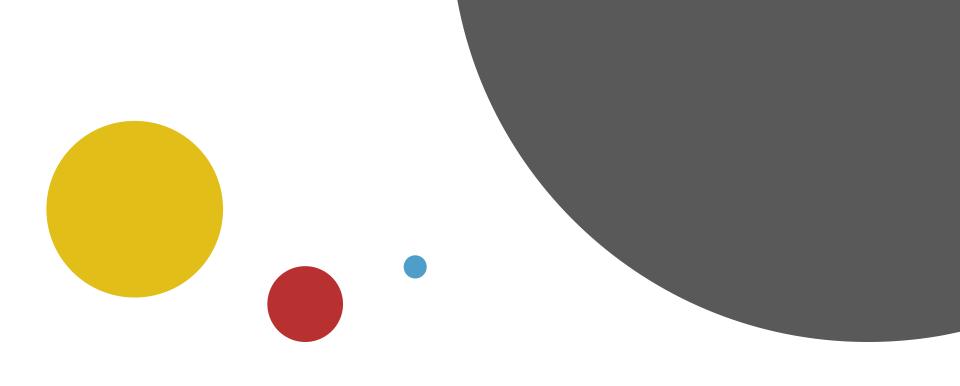
