Behavior-Based Interviewing

- "Tell me about a time when" or "Describe a situation where."
- Past behavior is an indicator of future performance.
- Focused on core competencies
- Types of Questions
 - Open-ended questions
 - Related to core competencies
 - Successes & challenges



How to succeed in a government interview

- 1. Identify specific skills in job bulletin or description.
- 2. For each major area, be prepared with examples of what you've done or approach you'd take to get up to speed.
- 3. Prepare a short impactful "history" or your career, stressing matches with skills needed.
- 4. Be ready to answer how you prepared for the interview.
- 5. Be punctual, be professional in appearance, and make eye contact.
- 6. Review sample interview questions for the position.
- 7. Ask a colleague or friend to conduct a practice interview with you.
- 8. Get someone to do a video recording of you in a practice interview.
- 9. Do not criticize or belittle your current or past employer.
- 10. If you are an internal candidate, be careful not to undersell yourself.

- Provide about 15-20 minutes of interviewing for each "candidate" (starting with aspirant for Accounting Manager and then Finance Director)
- Offer 10-15 minutes of feedback to each "candidate"
- 4. Conduct 15 minutes of Q&A with audience (might do a few minutes after each "candidate")
