### Introduction

The California Society of Municipal Finance Officers (CSMFO) Board of Directors met via teleconference on Thursday, June 24, 2021. President Marcus Pimentel convened the meeting and confirmed a quorum was in attendance at 2:01 p.m. The meeting began with a review of the organization's mission and a quiz. There were no additions to the agenda.

#### **Consent Calendar**

The Board addressed the consent calendar, which included the minutes from the May meeting, the financial reports from May 2021, the 2020 audit, the 2021 audit RFP and the Executive Committee meeting agenda. Auditor Ingrid Sheipline provided a brief overview of the 2020 audit. Past President Steve Heide moved to approve the consent calendar; Director Ernie Reyna seconded. The motion passed unanimously.

### **GFOA Update on CPFO Program**

Eric Roach from GFOA provided the Board with an overview of their revised Certified Public Finance Officer (CPFO) program, including their willingness to working with CSMFO to build a California-specific add-on certificate.

### SMA Contract Addendum/Budget Amendment

Administration Committee Chair Alberto Preciado presented to the Board a draft addendum to the CSMFO contract with SMA to remove from their contract the services provided by Harriet Commons. In addition, the combination of that addendum and Harriet's direct contract require a budget adjustment of an additional \$8600 expense to the management contract line. Past President Heide moved to approve both the addendum and the budget adjustment. Director Karla Romero seconded, and the motion passed unanimously.

### 2024 & 2025 Annual Conference Site Selection

Past President Heide shared with the Board the Executive Committee's recommendation to contract with the Disneyland Hotel for the 2024 Annual Conference and the San Jose Convention Center for the 2025 Annual Conference, including addressing potential size concerns relating to the 2024 contract and 2025 expenses. Director Stephen Parked moved to approve the 2024 contract with the Disneyland Hotel, and Director Reyna seconded. Director Parker moved to approve the 2025 contract with the San Jose Convention Center pending legal review and a reduced food and beverage minimum. Director Grace Castaneda seconded and the motion passed unanimously.

### **Executive Search Firm Recommendation**

President Pimentel shared with the Board the RFP process for identifying a firm to assist with the search for an executive director, as well as the recommendation from the Ad Hoc committee to allow President Pimentel to negotiate a contract with CPS Human Resources. Director Reyna so moved, and Director Parker seconded. The motion passed unanimously.

#### **Consideration for Future Executive Director Search**

President Pimentel shared with the Board thoughts and ideas for consideration in drafting the job description and salary range for the new executive director, and proposed holding a special Board meeting on July 14 to discuss just this issue. Director Romero moved to schedule the meeting for July 14; Director Will Fuentes seconded. The motion passed unanimously.

### **Committee Reports**

### Administration

Chair Alberto Preciado shared that the committee is researching providing CPE certificates for out-of-state webinar attendees, will be conducting an RFP for audit services and is drafting a revision to the policy manual to bring to the Board this summer for approval.

### Career Development

Chair Laura Nomura shared that the ARPA webinar had nearly 600 attendees with a 9/10 rating.

#### **Communications**

Board Liaison Romero shared that readership has increased by 30%, up to roughly 350 views this month, and that there is a new option at the end of the articles to rate them.

### Membership

Past President Heide shared that they are working on vetting the member v. nonmember benefits, and the Commercial Member Roundtable would be happening again in July. Margaret Moggia shared an update on the cohort programs.

### Professional Standards

Chair Jason Al-Imam shared that the committee pushed out a Quick Hit video from PFM on private market securities, which had nearly 100 views. They are also working on highlights related to ARPA.

### Program

Margaret Moggia shared that the deadline for call for presentations is coming soon.

### Recognition

Chair Michael Manno shared that the committee is finalizing the order for the physical plaques. They are also working on a volunteer reviewer recruitment article for the CSMFO News, and will be working on updating and reaffirming the list of current reviewers for the upcoming budget award year.

### Student Engagement

Chair Amber Johnson shared via written report that they are working on a blueprint to engage schools near the CSMFO annual conference, and foster relationships with schools across the state. They are also working with the Membership Committee on a joint membership brochure to make students aware of our Early Career membership category.

### Technology

Chair Gloriann Sasser shared that the committee is working on evaluating learning management systems, which has entailed viewing demonstrations of three different platforms. She also shared that the committee vice chair position is currently vacant.

#### **Chapter Roundtable**

President Pimentel shared that the South San Joaquin Chapter held the first in-person meeting since the beginning of the pandemic.

#### **League Policy Committee Updates**

In addition to the written reports, Director Reyna shared he attended the Public Policy Safety Committee, the discussion at which centered on fireworks and alcohol.

### **Officer Reports**

President Pimentel shared his appreciation for Director Reyna spearheading the CSMFO Giants v. Dodgers game coming up in September. He also reminded everyone that chapters are able to hold in-person meetings now at will, depending on the restrictions of their local jurisdictions and the comfort level of their attendees. Further, there is a group of members in the leadership that are meeting with leaders of Colorado, Ohio, Michigan, Washington and Oregon state organizations to share ideas and best practices.

### **Other Discussion Items**

Executive Director Melissa Manchester shared that registration is now open for the Planning Session, being held October 10-12 at the Disneyland Hotel.

The next meeting will be held via teleconference on Thursday, July 27, 2021.

Meeting adjourned at 4:14 p.m.
