Change VS Transition

Change- situations or events that happen to people and organizations.

- Ex: Management leaving for new opportunities and having to work with a new person in their position.
- Ex: Could also occur when you move from one job to another and having to leave one set of coworkers and start working with new ones.

Transition- is the process of adapting to a new situation.

- Ex: The internal process you go through to adjust to working with the new manager
- Ex: Happens as you adapt and grow accustomed to your new team.

Align the Corporate Culture

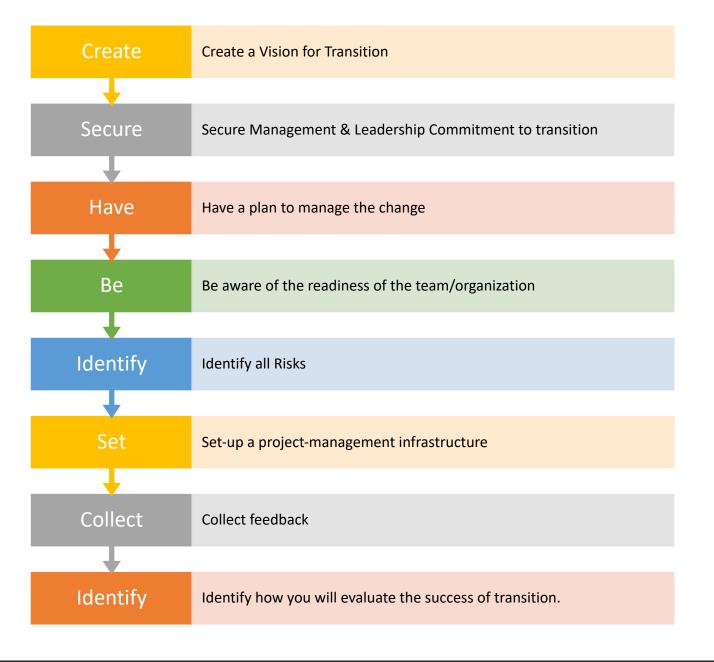

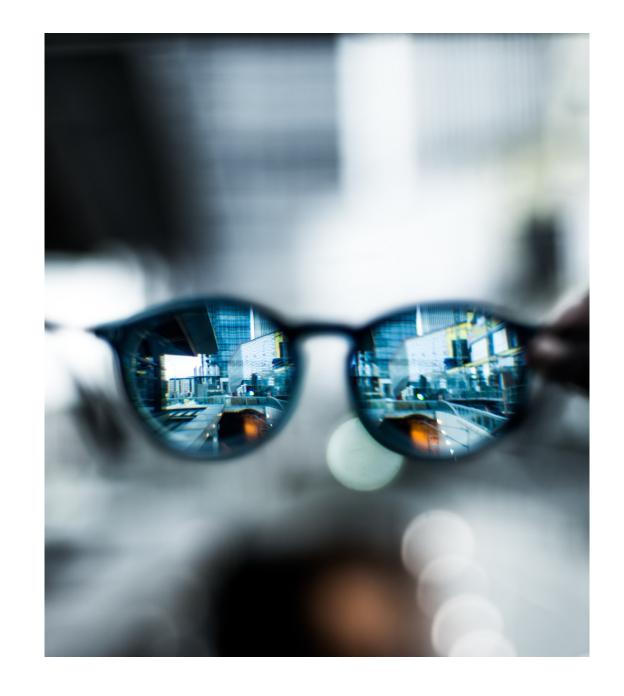

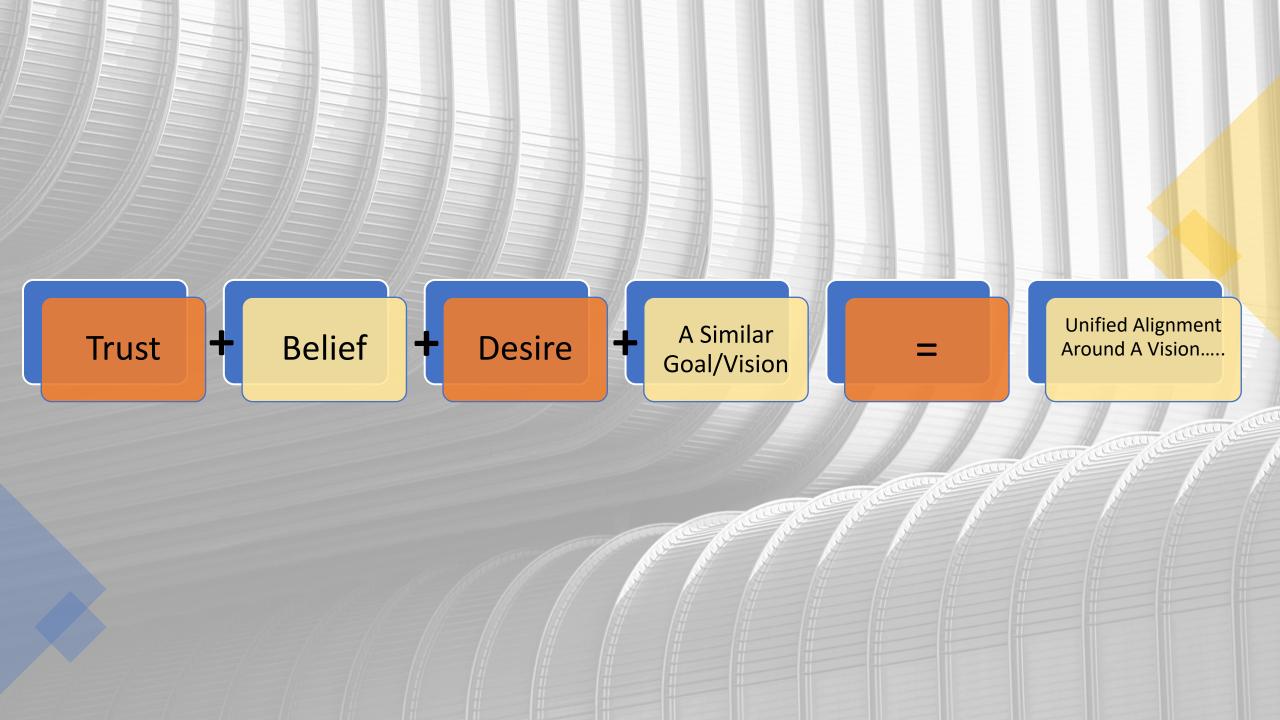
